

AEMB National Executive Council (NEC) Meeting Minutes

April 26, 2015, 1:00 PM Eastern time, via teleconference

Approval of prior NEC meeting minutes: Dr. Dominic Nathan moves to approve; approved unanimously

Old Business

- 1. Treasurer's report: Dr. Alicia Fernandez is traveling. Dr. Marcia Pool reported:
 - a. Current balance: \$27,464.39
 - i. This Spring: 178 new members with *paid* dues
 - ii. This Spring: 33 new members with unpaid dues
 - iii. One chapter (UIC) still with 10 outstanding dues from fall 2015; Marcia is working on
- 2. Status of the society: Dr. Marcia Pool reported:
 - a. New members
 - i. 15 chapters are inducting new members (12 chapters have paid dues)
 - ii. 178 paid members; 33 outstanding
 - b. New chapters (5 chapters going through process of approval)
 - i. University of Memphis (2015)—approved
 - ii. University of Maryland (2015)—waiting
 - iii. Indiana Tech (2015)—waiting
 - iv. The Catholic University of America (2015)—waiting
 - v. University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign (2015)—waiting
- 4. Database of members, past and present: Update by Mr. Bhavit Vora:
 - a. Will start sending e-mails this summer to past members
 - b. Has been emailing chapters but will begin calling chapter advisor
- 5. Chapter development: Update Mr. Justin Huckaby and/or Ms. Morgan Elliott
 - a. Justin no responses yet via email; long wait time for response
 - b. Recent contact: Indiana University- recruited faculty member
 - c. Dr. Terri may need 6 months to hear back from faculty members

 - 3. Investigate options (table or background)
 - 4. Store the banner in a poster tube
 - 5. Possibly 6 feet x 3 feet?
 - ii. AEMB-logoed give away items for the national chapter meeting at BMES
 - 1. Pens (\$0.35), keychains, bottle openers (\$0.50), headphones, glass etching (Marquette), bag tags, backpack clothespin buttons and possibly magnets
 - 2. Marcia can store the equipment
 - 3. Morgan: raffles for premium items (also good way to increase database)

- 7. Resume book: Update Mr. David Wolfson.

- a. Compile a list of instructional videos for resume book
- b. David: new resume template will be sent so everyone can see
- c. Request resumes from chapters
- d. Justin: Some options from instructional videos on career development
 - i. Send with resume requests; part of instructions
 - ii. Collect a group of links from public sites
 - iii. Prize competition for best student career building video
 - 1. Such as Best Student Produced Video / Best Professional Video
 - 2. Interview like video? Coordinate with industry people?
 - 3. Possibly advertise in newsletter
- e. Resume layout should go on our website
- f. Advertisement: have students doing internships mention resume book to companies
- g. Options for compiled resume book:
 - i. A password-access cloud database for companies at BMES
 - ii. Create a password-protected EXCEL/WORD sheet on a cloud database
 - iii. Only give password to companies with whom we are establishing relationships
 - iv. Burning CDs with resume book may be a better option
 - 1. Small business card-sized CDs: could be given out at BMES
- 8. Newsletter: Dr. Marcia Pool
 - a. Trying to get one out by the end of May:
 - b. Working on this but still need to finish some ideas
 - c. Advertise student videos in newsletter
 - d. Terri will write President's Letter (doesn't need to go on the front page)
 - i. Something exciting will go on front page

- 9. Other old business: New chapter petitions
 - a. Most of the old petitions had been approved
 - i. Justin saved all in-progress AEMB chapter petitions and will send in one email to all
 - b. Catholic University GPA requirement of 3.0 and if below, essay can be written
 - i. Needs to keep with the National constitution (upper 1/3 of class)

New Business

- 1. NSF Conference Grant: Progress report Dr. Teresa Murray
 - a. Videos from 2012 conference are now available online: in partial accordance with 2012 NSF grant
 - b. Tried to get grant since then but have not been successful
 - i. The past NSF BMES program chair could not fund any more grants in 2013
 - ii. In 2014, the new NSF BME program chair did not fully understand the separation between BMES and AEMB. He had already funded travel grants for students to attend BMES for the BMES-AEMB-APS jointly sponsored authorship workshop and could not exceed his limit for a conference grant for the conference.
 - c. New program chair now understands what money is for
 - i. Likes the concept of having a design workshop on wearable technology (Alicia & Terri)
 - ii. Need a 2 page description (\$18k \$20k total requested money)
 - 1. Full Fastlane submission process
 - 2. Terri, Alicia, Dominic, Marci, and Bhavit can work on it
 - iii. Need industry partners to help facilitate & mentor new design for commercialization
 - iv. ~20 students in 5 groups work with a mentor at the conference to discuss options
 - 1. Groups will continue discussion and work with mentors for next few months
 - 2. Students ultimately make a video pitch or kickstarter page
 - v. Just for travel grants will not get much money
 - d. Needs progress asap; will work in summer on this
